He has also been an examiner for PhD theses for several Australian Universities. His peer-reviewed publications number >100 and he was Chair of the Wet Tropics Management Authority until recently and a Director of Terrain NRM for 8 years. He is currently President of the Tree Kangaroo and Mammal Group and is Conservation Officer for Birdlife Northern Queensland.
